TIAM dissemination in West Bohemia of Czech

Thanks to the Regional Contact Organization for West Bohemia the TIAM project has got more publicity.

The Regional Contact Organization for West Bohemia (RKO ZČ) has been created in 2000 within the network of regional and contact organizations with the support of the Ministry of Education, Youth and Sports programme EUPRO. It was created as the joint project of the University of West Bohemia (UWB) with BIC Plzeň (Business and Innovation Centre) and ŠKODA RESEARCH as project partners.

The main tasks of the RKO ZČ have been:

- to support participation of teams of researchers, institutes and companies operating in the West Bohemia in programmes of international cooperation in research and development,
- to contribute to the development of international cooperation of research laboratories with industry and small and medium size enterprises.

Within the project The Regional Contact Organization for West Bohemia the publication summarizing selected project has been prepared. The publication presents projects of international cooperation in research and technological development with participants from the Plzeň region. The publication is written in both Czech and English language. Brief description of the TIAM project is also included. 500 pieces of this publication are now distributed to particular researchers and on different national and international events.
