TIAM dissemination seminary was held in the beginning of September at Science and Technology Park in Pilsen. The international seminary was organized by the University of West Bohemia, the partner of the TIAM project.

The aim of the event was to introduce main ideas and results of the TIAM project to a wide spectrum of ergonomics experts. Participants representing Czech Ergonomic Society, Occupational Medicine Clinic, Faculty of Health Care Study or Siemens Company and, of course, also students of the University of West Bohemia should compare different approaches in the risk assessment of work related musculoskeletal disorders (WMSDs) from the point of view of regions participating in the TIAM project.
